Bible Lesson:

Abraham has child with Hagar (Genesis 16:1-16)

MV: Isaiah 26:7

<u>Point Lesson:</u> In this lesson we'll be exploring the time in Abraham's life where he and his wife Sarah thought that their own way of doing things was better than God's way of doing things. Ishmael was born and along with it a lot of problems and heartache for their lives, as well as for the lives of many of those around them. <u>Point of Decision:</u> God's way is the best way for our lives, but choosing His way is a choice that only you can make for yourself. If you want to choose to live God's way and not your own way, then we can pray together right now.

TRUST GOD WITH YOUR PROBLEMS



Bible Lesson:

SThe Widows Oil (2 Kings 4:1-7)

MV: Jeremiah 17:7

<u>Point Lesson</u>: This lesson is inspired by the Old Testament account of the widow's oil. When looking at this woman's life, she found herself with a big problem that was way too big for her to solve. She needed help and she went to the right place: to Elisha, the man of God, and trusted that God could help her, which He did in such an unusual and unexpected way. One important takeaway from that situation is that we should do likewise when we are faced with our own big problems. It's important that children learn from an early age that they can trust God with their problems and that He is willing and able to work things out for them.

<u>Point of Decision:</u> In your life you might be facing one or more problems that are big and out of your control. Always remember, you can bring your problems to God and ask Him for His help. If you want to do that, then we can pray together right now. Following up on " God has a plan " Wk 3

GOD CAN WORK ALL THINGS FOR YOUR GOOD



Bible Lesson:

Life of Joseph (Genesis 37,39-48, 50)

MV: Romans 8:28

<u>Point Lesson</u>: This lesson is inspired by Romans 8:28 - that God can work all things together for the good of those who love Him and are called according to His purpose. Although children are young it is still important for them to learn and know some incredibly important and helpful truths, this verse being one of them. It is important to keep in mind that God has the unique ability and power to work together ALL things; hard times, failures, challenges, etc. for our good. What we might see as a waste, God can work into something that is for our good!

<u>Point of Decision:</u> God is able to work all things together for the good of those who love Him and are called according to His purpose for them. Today you can choose to give your life over to God and allow Him to work all things together for your good. If you want to do that then we can pray together now.

GOD HAS A PLAN FOR YOUR LIFE



Bible Lesson:

Jonah and the whale (Jonah 1,2)

MV: Jeremiah 29:11

<u>Point Lesson:</u> The point of this lesson is to show the children that God has a plan for their lives. He has a good plan to give them a hope & a future, but it still comes down to the decisions that they make in their lives. Those decisions, whether good or bad, will determine whether or not they move closer & closer to God's plan for them or farther & farther away from it. God gives us free will & let's us make our own decisions for our lives & we have to live with the consequences of our decisions. Thankfully, God is always there to help us make the right decisions & guide us in the right direction. That is why it is best for us to make it a habit to stop & seek God for help & direction in our lives. When we do that we can know that we'll see God's best & God's plan happen in our lives.

<u>Point of Decision:</u> For the children to take a moment to stop & seek help from God & ask Him to help them make good decisions every day of their lives.
